Ppeolbae is the only way of transportation used by fishermen when digging out cockles and clams in mud flats. Boseong mud flats are composed of a mixture of minute mud particles and water.

This mixture results in legs sinking into the mud as soon as people take a step in the mud flats. Thus, fishermen of Boseong invented Ppeolbae, so they can work without getting stuck in the mud.
